# Clinical Exam ChatGPT Prompts

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## **GENERAL POINTERS**

- 1. Have a SHORT CASE CHAT and a LONG CASE CHAT in ChatGPT. Continue to use these same chats for each session.
- 2. The first time, give a long prompt with all the context.
- 3. Give feedback as you go if not quite right it will "learn" for next time and get better and better.

NB: I would strongly recommend using the audio input tool to practise presenting verbally but this does required a paid ChatGPT account for longer audio.

# SHORT CASES

#### Initial prompt for new chat:

"I am a <u>PAEDIATRIC/ADULT</u> basic trainee registrar preparing for the Royal Australasian College of Physicians Divisional Clinical Examination. I want this chat to be a place where I can prepare for the short case aspect of the examination.

In the short case I cannot ask any further history. The patient will typically have a chronic medical condition with subsequent clinical signs that can be found on examination.

I will examine the patient for 7 minutes and then I will summarise and list at least 3 differentials and investigations for the examiners.

Once I finish examining I cannot go back and continue examining. Don't give me feedback between each answer - act as the examiner."

You can add common conditions that come up/common issues here too.

#### 1 A FULL CASE

"GIVE me a brief stem for a short case and tell me what kind of examination you want me to do.

I will talk through my examination approach.

Tell me what the findings were and I will say if I want to examine anything else.

Don't give me feedback at this stage.

When I am done, ask me for my differentials and then the investigations I would order. Then give me the results of the investigations I ask for and I can interpret them"

#### To finish:

"Please give me feedback. Summarise the things I got wrong or forgot about during today's case. Are any of them recurring problems?"

#### 2 DIFFERENTIALS and INVESTIGATIONS RAPID FIRE

"QUIZ me on examination findings and what the main differentials could be and what investigations I would order. Make me interpret the investigations."

# LONG CASES

### Initial prompt for new chat:

"I am a <u>PAEDIATRIC/ADULT</u> basic trainee registrar preparing for the Royal Australasian College of Physicians Divisional Clinical Examination. I want this chat to be a place where I can prepare for the LONG case aspect of the examination.

For the long case, I have a total of 60 minutes with the patient for history and examination, followed by 10 minutes for preparation and a 25-minute discussion with the examiner (which is 10-12 minutes where I present the case and the main issues I've identified, and 13-15 minutes of questions from the examiners).

The patient must have a complex medical condition/s with lots of complications and social implications/complexity."

You can add common conditions that come up/common issues here too.

#### 1 ENTIRE CASE

Please act as a long case <u>PATIENT/PARENT</u> for me that I can take a history from in 50 minutes. After that I would like 10 minutes to prepare my presentation, then I would like you do act as the examiner while I present the case and my issues and then you ask me more about my management issues.

Don't give me too much information without me asking or prompt me.

NB: you can get chat GPT to talk back to you!



### 2 Present a real case "hot"

If you have a practice case lined up but no one to present it to immediately, use ChatGPT.

NB: you need to be <u>really</u> careful about confidentiality if you do this (don't use real names. If very rare diseases be vague about diagnosis)

#### 3 ISSUES DISCUSSION

Get ChatGPT to present a case to you briefly with the main issues listed and you can discuss your approach to managing each issue.
